HIGH GRAVITY BEERS AT BLUEGRASS BEVERAGES

- ❑ Kentucky Pumpkin Barrel Ale, [Alltech's Lexington Brewery](#)
Barrel-aged ale brewed with Kentucky-sourced pumpkin, spiced with cinnamon, nutmeg and allspice. At 10 percent alcohol by volume (ABV), it's a robust sipping brew perfect for the fall season.
- ❑ Fat Jack, [Saumel Adams](#)
This rich and luscious brew indulges in flavor with over 28 lbs. of pumpkin per barrel, for a full bodied sweetness and deep russet color.

LOW GRAVITY BEERS AT BLUEGRASS MARKET & DELI

- ❑ New Castle Werewolf, [New Castle](#)
Brewed with rye malts and offering mellow overtones of slight berry fruit and roasted caramel notes with a lingering deep bite of bitterness from Fuggle and Golding hops, Newcastle Werewolf has an alcohol by volume (ABV) of 4.5 percent with 23.4 International Bittering Units (IBUs). Oh, and it's blood red.

Copper in color, this medium bodied beer is the perfect blend of roasted malts just the right amount of hops to capture a true representation of the style.
